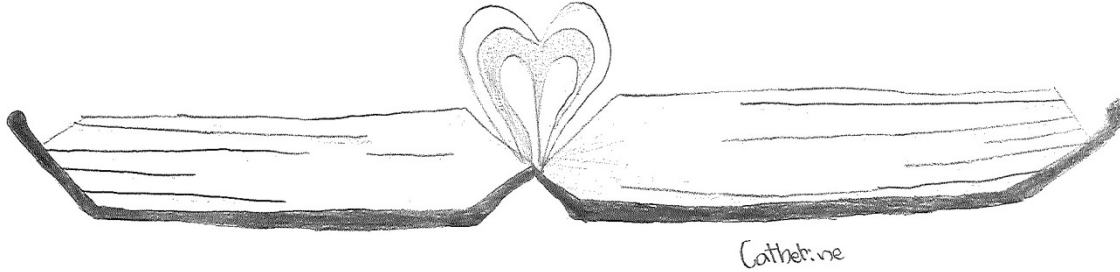


God's Unfailing Love



Attributes of God

Infinite – God is Self-Existing, without beginning or end; “He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.” Col. 1:17

Immutable – He never changes; “I the Lord do not change.” Malachi 3:6a

Self-Sufficient – He has no needs; “For as the Father has life in Himself, so He has granted the Son also to have life in Himself.” John 5:26

Omnipotent – God is all powerful; “By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, their starry host by the breath of His mouth.” Psalm 33:6

Omniscient – all knowing; “Remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is none like me; declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times, things not yet done, saying, “My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose.”” Isaiah 46: 9-10

Omnipresent – He is always everywhere; “Where can I go from Your Spirit: Where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend to heaven, You are there; If I make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the dawn, If I dwell in the remotest parts of the sea, even there Your hand will lead me, And Your right hand will lay hold of me.” Psalm 139:7-10

Wise – He is full of perfect wisdom; “Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!” Romans 11:33

Faithful – Infinitely, unchangingly true; “Know therefore that the Lord your God is God. He is the faithful God, keeping His covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love Him and keep His commandments.” Deuteronomy 7:9

Good – He is infinitely, unchangingly kind – full of good will; “O, taste and see that the Lord is good” Psalm 34:8

Just – God is infinitely, unchangeably right and perfect in all He does; “The Rock! His work is perfect, for all His ways are just; A God of faithfulness and without injustice, Righteous and upright is He.” Deuteronomy 32:4

Merciful – He is infinitely, unchangeably compassionate and kind; “I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion.” Romans 9:15-16

Gracious – God is infinitely inclined to spare the guilty; “The Lord is gracious and merciful; slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.” Psalm 145:8

Holy – God is infinitely, unchangingly perfect; “Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord Almighty” Revelation 4:8

Glorious – God is infinitely beautiful and great; “His brightness is like the sun, rays come forth from His hand, that is where His power is concealed.” Habakkuk 3:4

Loving – God infinitely, unchangingly love us; “Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.” 1 John 4:7-8

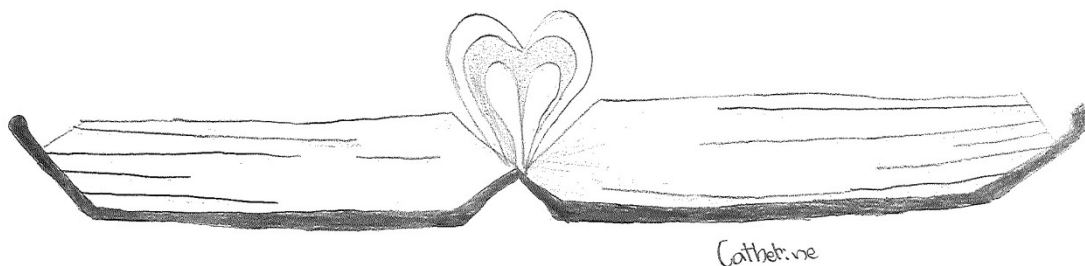

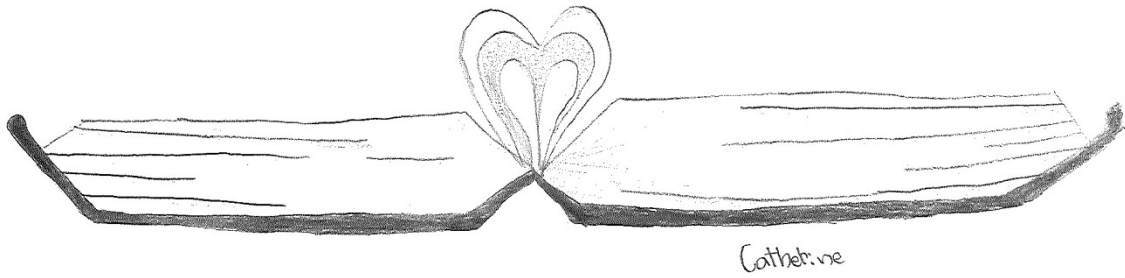
